RECIPE

Ginger Cake (Class 1)

4oz margarine
4oz golden syrup
4oz dark muscovado sugar
6oz self-raising flour
1 ½ level tsp cinnamon
1 ½ level tsp ground ginger
1 level tsp bicarbonate of soda
1 beaten egg
¼ pint milk

Method

Melt sugar, margarine and syrup in a saucepan. Sift flour and spices in a bowl.
Stir melted mixture into dry ingredients and add egg.
Warm milk, add bicarbonate of soda to milk and stir into mixture.
Pour into a loaf tin (4" x 8" approx.).
Cook for approx. 1 hour at 325F/165C/Gas 3.
